■ 2009 Student Residential Fees

This booklet explains the 2009 Student Residential Fees associated with student accommodation provided at Longerenong College. It also explains important information about eligibility for student accommodation and the bonds and other charges that may apply.

Please take the time to read this booklet carefully before you enrol.

Please note that the information given in this booklet relates to students undertaking a tertiary or post-secondary course who choose to stay in the Student Residences at Longerenong College only.

■ Who is eligible for Student Accommodation?

Any student doing a tertiary course is eligible for accommodation at student rates at Longerenong College. Preference will be given to our own students however students studying at other institutions are welcome to apply.

■ What is the accommodation like?

Accommodation is provided in the College's Student Residences which have carpeted single rooms and shared facilities. The rooms have a bed and mattress, study desk and chair and built in robe. Shared facilities include bathrooms, kitchens, lounges and laundry. Recreational facilities include a swimming pool, squash court, tennis courts, gymnasium and student lounge with pool table, table tennis table and entertainment system.

■ What meals are provided?

Meals are provided to resident students as follows:

- Breakfast (Monday to Friday)
- Lunch (Friday only)
- Dinner (Monday to Thursday)

All meals are served in the Dining Room. Morning tea and lunch (Monday to Thursday) as well as snacks, drinks etc. can be purchased from the café in the Dining Room.

Note that meals are not provided and the café does not operate on Public Holidays observed by the College.

■ What options are available?

Several packages are offered to cater for the requirements of most students as follows:

- Long Term Accommodation
- Medium Term Accommodation
- Casual Accommodation

Fees for all packages cover accommodation, power, gas, water and meals.

■ Long Term Accommodation

The Long Term Accommodation package is available only to students who elect to live in the Student Residences for the full academic year and has the cheapest rate. Students from other institutions pay slightly higher rates.

Note:

- i. The weekly rates include GST on meals (GST is not charged on the accommodation).
- ii. Linen is not included. There is an additional charge of \$11 (including GST) per week if linen is required.

- iii. A Room Bond of \$200 and a Room Key Deposit of \$15 are required.

Long Term accommodation is payable each semester for a full semester in advance. Students seeking other payment arrangements must contact the Campus Manager.

■ Medium Term Accommodation

The Medium Term Accommodation package is available only to students who elect to live in the Student Residences for a full semester and has the next cheapest rates to the Long Term package. Students from other institutions pay slightly higher rates.

Note:

- i. The weekly rates include GST on meals (GST is not charged on the accommodation).
- ii. Linen is not included. There is an additional charge of \$11 (including GST) per week if linen is required.
- iii. A Room Bond of \$200 and a Room Key Deposit of \$15 are required.

Medium Term accommodation is payable for a full semester in advance. Students seeking other payment arrangements must contact the Campus Manager.

■ Casual Accommodation

Casual rates are charged for all other accommodation provided. Because of the short term nature of this type of accommodation the casual rate is higher than the other rates. Again, students from other institutions pay slightly higher rates.

Note:

- i. Linen is not included. There is an additional charge of \$11 (including GST) per week if linen is required.
- ii. Resident students will be charged for any damage they cause to their room or to the common areas of the residences (excluding fair wear and tear).

■ How do I apply?

If you are enrolling in a full time course at Longerenong College you will receive an Application for Student Accommodation with your enrolment package. You must complete this form and return it to the College.

If you are a student from another institution you should contact us to see if suitable accommodation is available. If it is you will be sent an Application for Student Accommodation to be completed and returned to us.

Casual accommodation is available, subject to availability of rooms, throughout the academic year. You should contact us if you require casual accommodation.

■ Do I have to sign anything?

If you take up either Long or Medium Term accommodation, or Casual accommodation for any term exceeding one week, you will have to sign a licence agreement. This agreement sets out your rights and responsibilities as the Licensee and our rights and responsibilities as the Licensor for full term of accommodation.

Once you have signed the licence agreement you will be expected to honour it. Should you want to vacate the residences and terminate the agreement before it expires you will need to give the College four (4) weeks written notice of your intention including the reason(s) why you want to vacate.

There will be an early termination fee and, depending on your reasons, you may still be held liable for the fees for the full term of the agreement .
